## **STUDENT** FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The Interdisciplinary School of Health Sciences (ISHS) at Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) is recognized as a Center of Excellence (CoE) for 'Preclinical Study on Development of Therapeutic Adjuvants based on Ayurveda' by Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India in December 2017. The CoE works in collaboration with reputed institutes such as National Centre for Cell Sciences, Pune; Indian Institute of Science Education and Research, Pune; Serum Institute of India Limited, Pune; School of Life Sciences, Manipal Academy of Higher Education, Manipal; Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, USA and National Cancer Institute, National Institutes of Health, USA.

The major activities of CoE are human resource development, transdisciplinary research, and capacity building. The 'Student Fellowship Program' is designed to encourage transdisciplinary research in AYUSH systems. The fellowship aims to inspire students from SPPU departments to undertake master projects on Ayurveda and Yoga. Ten fellowships will be awarded for the year 2018.
