

THE FELLOWSHIP

Selected students will be awarded a consolidated fellowship of **INR.28,000/-** and a certificate after successful completion of the approved research project. Additional financial aid may be provided for selected projects. The CoE will conduct workshops and training programs for selected students. The selected fellows may also get complementary registration for the national symposium organized by AYUSH CoE in 2019.

ELIGIBILITY

The Master's students from any discipline who are in the 2nd or 3rd Semester of their course.

APPLICATION PROCESS
